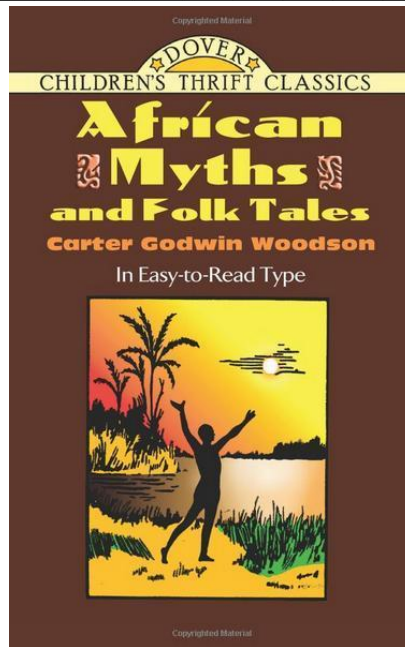
**RULES**
